An individual can submit an application on their own or as a representative of a youth group. All proposals should be submitted by email to keisha.francis@toronto.ca.

The submission deadline is March 2, 2020. Proposals will be reviewed by a panel of judges and the top three projects will be selected. The selected applicants will be given an opportunity to present their proposal at the Scarborough Centre Youth Forum on Saturday, March 21, 2020 hosted by Deputy Mayor Michael Thompson.

### When will the contest be open?

Entries will be accepted from January 31, 2020- March 2, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.

### Who can participate?

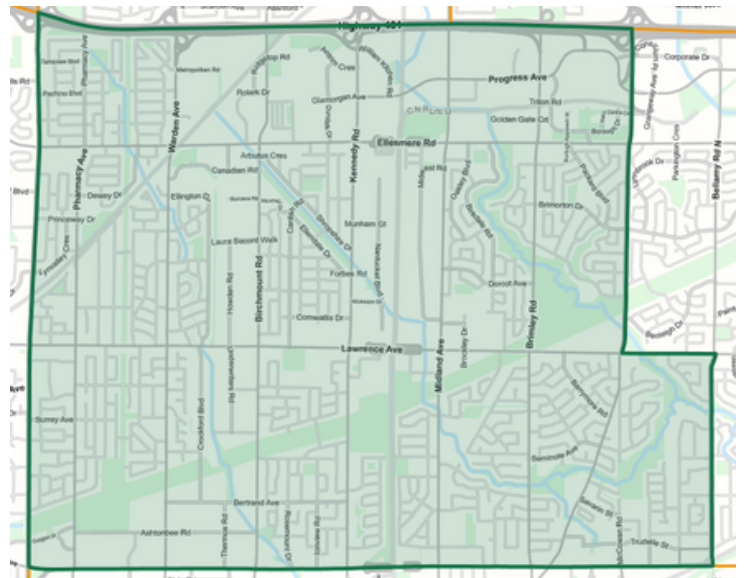
Youth ages 13-21 years old who lives in Ward 21, Scarborough Centre (see map)

### How do I participate?

Submit a proposal on how to make Scarborough a better place for Youth. Participants may choose from three categories below:

1. Visual - design a poster, infographic, photo collage or any visual art
2. Written - submit a short article, proposal, poem or essay of no more than 400 words
3. Video/Audio - create a video or audio piece no longer than five minutes

### What do I need to know before I submit my entry?

All entrants must e-mail Keisha.Francis@toronto.ca prior to submitting a proposal in order to receive the full contest details and consent form.

### Can my contest entry be disqualified?

An entry will be disqualified if:

- It is late, illegible or inaudible, incomplete, forged or reproduced;
- Any third-party trademarks, brands and/or logos are used or displayed in any part of the submission, obviously or subliminally;
- It negatively depicts another person, country, race, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation or disability; or
- It contains content deemed offensive or inappropriate including but not limited to nudity, vulgarity or violence.

### How will you select the entries to be showcased?

Entries will be selected on the basis of creativity, innovative thinking and overall community impact.

### My entry has been selected! What next?

Selected individuals will be invited to join Deputy Mayor Michael Thompson at the Scarborough Centre Youth Forum on Saturday, March 21st from 10am-3pm where they will be given the opportunity to present their proposal.

If for any reason a selected participant cannot be reached through the contact information provided, or does not respond within seven days of being contacted, their entry will not be accepted and another participant will be selected.
